Long Beach Transit Offers Free Transportation on Election Day
To get customers to the polls, LBT will offer free rides on November 6.

LONG BEACH, CALIF. (October 30, 2018) – Last week the LBT Board of Directors approved offering free rides on Election Day to get people to the voting polls and encourage voter participation. The action is part of a regional effort to increase voter turnout.

“Getting to the polls should not be a barrier to voting,” said McDonald. “With free service on LBT buses and Dial-A-Lift, voters in all the cities we serve can experience public transit and have their voices heard at the polls. We welcome the opportunity to serve new and current customers on November 6.”

In addition to its regularly scheduled, fixed-route bus service, LBT will offer free rides for its eligible Dial-A-Lift customers. Dial-A-Lift is LBT’s paratransit service for those with permanent mobility impairments.
